Eligibility and Instructions

Eligibility:

1. Enrolled in a university located in the state of Arizona.
2. Enrolled in a Bachelor degree program related to transportation planning/engineering/construction.
3. Must be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student in your junior or senior year for the Fall 2017 semester.
4. Must not be on academic probation.
5. Must not have already received an ASHE scholarship in a prior year
6. Must be able to accept the award in person at the August 16, 2017 ASHE Member Appreciation Event in Scottsdale, AZ

Instructions:

1. Download the PDF application from the ASHE Sonoran Section Web Site located at: <http://sonoran.ashe.pro>
2. Complete the application. The application must be typed and your responses cannot exceed the space provided.
3. Attach a copy of your current (Fall 2016 & Spring 2017) transcripts.

If Awarded:

1. If you are awarded the scholarship, write a short thank you note to the scholarship committee.
2. Mark your calendar. If you are awarded the scholarship, you must accept the award in person at the August 16, 2017 ASHE Member Appreciation Event in Scottsdale, AZ
