*For college students pursuing a degree and career related to the planning, design, or construction of highways.
It is ASHE's intent to award at least 3 scholarships to 3 separate eligible candidates.*

Eligibility and Instructions

Eligibility:

1. Enrolled in a university located in the state of Arizona.
2. Enrolled in a Bachelor degree program related to transportation planning/engineering/construction.
3. Must be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student in your junior or senior year for the Fall 2018 semester.
4. Must not be on academic probation.
5. Must not have already received an ASHE scholarship in a prior year
6. Must be able to accept the award in person at the August 2018 ASHE Member Appreciation Event in Scottsdale, AZ (exact date to be determined).

Instructions:

2. Complete the application. The application must be typed and your responses cannot exceed the space provided.
3. Attach a copy of your current (Fall 2017 & Spring 2018) transcripts.

If Awarded:

I understand that if offered an award I must accept the award in person at the August 2018 ASHE Member Appreciation Event (exact date to be determined).
