




SCHEDULE

 - 2022, over 106,000 residents and growing
- HDR was selected as the Consultant Team
- Notice to Proceed August of 2023
- Approximate 18-month Schedule
- Final Document December of 2023



- Wraps up in May with a Recommendation
- Potential November 2023 Election





SR 303 Extension

A CRITICAL ECONOMIC INVESTMENT

- Proposition 400 Approved Project
- 303 and I-10 Traffic Interchange Opened to Traffic in 2019
- Planned Connection South to SR 30
- City of Goodyear Proactively Preserved Right-of-Way
- Van Buren to MC 85 Fully Funded (NHPP and RARF)
 - Pre-design and Environmental began in 2017
 - MAG TIP Identified
 - Design in FY 25
 - Construction in FY 27
 - MAG Accelerated Project 2022
 - Currently in Final Design Approaching 90% (\$12 mil)
 - Right-of Way Acquisition On-going (\$49 mil)
 - Construction Programmed in FY 25 (\$257 mil)
- Development has Occurred near the 303 alignment Anticipating Construction of the 303
 - Canyon Trails Current & Planned 10,800 Units
 - Multiple Current and Future Single Family 9,900+ Units
 - Multiple Current and Future Multi-family 2,500+ Units
